Good Morning. I am very pleased to welcome you all to this August Assembly and extend my warmest greetings to one and all. I recall my statement made in the previous meetings of Academic Council and I would like, once again, to reiterate that I am not a stranger to this University which gives me greater confidence, strength and clarity to work towards our goal in this cordial atmosphere. It is my privilege and pride to highlight the academic and administrative accomplishments during the past six months.

#### 1. Research Funding

To widen the research area in the University the following proposals have been sent to University Grants Commission, New Delhi for the creation of four new Centres / Departments in the University with financial assistance :-

I take pleasure in informing this august body, that action has been initiated by the University to implement twenty five research programmes under "Humanities & Social



Sciences” stream, with four Coordinators, along with twenty seven Principal Investigators, with a budgetary allocation of Rs.320 Lakhs under UPE Phase II.

## 2. Student Welfare

The Students Safety Insurance Scheme has been implemented for the benefit of students of the University of Madras covering more than 1.5 Lakh students who are pursuing their degree programme in the University Departments and Affiliated Colleges. The scheme has been entrusted with the Nationalized Insurance Provider M/s The New India Insurance Company Limited for a period of three years from the academic year 2014-2015.

As part of the activities for students, our University organized a Dance Drama on “Velu Nachiar”, the historic women patriot from Tamil Nadu. The event was inaugurated by Dr.S.Ayyar, I.A.S. (Retd.), Tamil Nadu State Election Commissioner in the presence of Dr.M.Rajaram, I.A.S., Secretary, Department of Tamil Development and Information Department on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2015. The programme was attended by students from all four campuses and affiliated colleges of the University.

To enrich the students knowledge, Visiting Professors under UGC XII Plan Grant have been appointed in the University Departments viz., Department of Psychology, Ancient History and Archaeology, Department of Philosophy, Department of Library and Information Science and Department of Arabic, Persian and Urdu.

In order to promote quality assurance, stimulate the academic environment for promotion of quality in teaching-learning and research in Higher Education Institutions and encourage self-evaluation, accountability, autonomy and innovations in Higher Education Institutions, the University has conducted a two day NAAC Awareness Programme / Workshop for all the Principals of Non-Accredited and Re-



Accredited Affiliated Colleges on 28<sup>th</sup> -29<sup>th</sup> January 2015 for the benefit of students. This was fully funded by the NAAC.

Two seats under supernumerary for students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir have been created from the academic year 2015-2016 in all Affiliated Colleges of the University of Madras as suggested by the UGC.

All the Chairpersons of the Board of Studies of the UG/PG/Common Board have been requested to revise the Syllabus for all the Courses under CBCS pattern for the University Departments under CBCS pattern and Affiliated Colleges of the University. Accordingly, most of the syllabi for the courses have been revised and same are placed before the Academic Council for its consideration.

I am very happy to inform you that 53 Research Fellowships have been created to 29 Science Departments from DST - PURSE Grants.

### 3. Faculty

I am very pleased to inform this august body that Two Professors, One Associate Professor and Seven Assistant Professors have been appointed in the National Centre for Nanoscience and Nanotechnology as per the guidelines of the UGC. Now, the current strength of faculty at this National Centre stands at Three Professors, One Associate Professor and Nine Assistant Professors.

The University has identified 11 books authored by the University Faculty Members to be published by the University Publication Division.

### 4. Examination

I place on record my sincere thanks for the support extended by the Principals and teachers of all the Affiliated Colleges for the speedy publication of results of various examinations conducted by the University well in advance in November 2014. Likewise, the Institute of Distance Education

December 2014 examination result will also be published well in advance.

#### **5. E-Governance in examination wing**

As I informed in the last Academic Council meeting, that the examination related work through online has been done successfully for the smooth conduct of examination and results have been published much earlier than the stipulated date.

#### **6. Award of Degrees**

The University has conducted the Convocation up to date and the 157<sup>th</sup> Annual Convocation was held on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2014 at the Centenary Auditorium, University of Madras. Our alumni, former faculty, presently the Honorable Vice-Chairman of UGC, Professor H.Devaraj was the Chief Guest. One D.Sc, 213 Ph.D. Degrees and 60, 228 UG, PG Degrees including the IDE have been awarded.

#### **7. Infrastructure**

I am happy to inform the august body that the constructions of Guest House for Academic Staff College at Marina Campus, the Post Graduate and Research Scholar Hostel at Taramani Campus, International Students Hostel at Guindy Campus, Nano-Technology Building, Western side Campus Wall at Taramani Campus and the Renovation of existing Guest House at Marina Campus have been completed. Multi Storied Building at Taramani and Guindy Campuses and Insectarium Building are expected to be completed soon.

Further, I would like to inform the House, that initiatives have been taken for construction of college building for constituent college at Nemmeli at a cost of Rs.7.2 crores, and construction of Women's Hostel at RIASM campus at a cost of 2.83 crores.

A National Centre for Neurotoxicity Research to Assist Drug Development has been established at Taramani Campus.

It has already started functioning at the Department of Pharmacology and Environmental Toxicology, Taramani.

A fully functional Health Centre as well as a Psychological Counselling Centre is now operating in Chepauk, Marina, Guindy and Taramani Campuses.

#### **8. Students from abroad**

UCIR (University Centre for International Relations) had admitted five students for the II and IV Semesters - 2014-2015 from Italy and France to five Postgraduate Courses in the University either as part of MOU or sponsored by ICCR, ICHR, MHRD, Government of India. An Orientation Programme for the new foreign students was organised. A series of Guest Lectures by foreign dignitaries and subject experts in Sciences and Social Sciences were organised to benefit the scholarly community of the University. A new MOU has been signed with Oxford Centre for Hindu Studies, UK and Department of Philosophy University of Madras for a period of three years.

#### **9. New Affiliated Institutions and new courses granted to the existing affiliated institutions**

About five Arts and Science Colleges already affiliated to University of Madras have been granted permission for starting additional Under Graduate / Post Graduate Courses for the academic year 2014-2015. The following are the new courses instituted during the academic year 2014 - 2015 :-

1. B. Voc. Course in Retail Management and Information Technology
2. B. Voc. Course in Hospitality and Tourism
3. P.G. Diploma in Banking and Finance (Self-Supportive Course)

#### **10. Funding**

A starter grant of Rs.2 Lakhs was sanctioned and released for each faculty who are appointed during the year 2014-2015 to the Science Departments from DST PURSE and University Funds. Similarly, a sum of Rs.2 Lakhs was

sanctioned from University funds and released for each faculty who are appointed during the year 2014-2015 to the Social Science Departments. A sum of Rs.2.42 crores for sports facility has been sanctioned by the UGC, New Delhi.

I seek your continued cooperation and guidance in all our academic endeavors and look forward to elevate and enhance the glory, grace and the institutional image of this University of Madras.

**The Vice-Chancellor:** I extend a hearty welcome to all the new members of the Academic Council.

**Dr. Fathima Vasanth:** Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and the Members of the august Body, I was just wondering if the Vice-Chancellor would follow the customary practice of giving few minutes to comment on the introductory remarks. Thank you very much Sir. First of all I would like to congratulate you and the University administration for all the new initiatives that you have reported in your report. Many of the self-financing colleges do not have single MOU and you know it is very important for academic institutions if you really raise the quality you also need to look out for several networks of higher quality in education. I request the Vice-Chancellor to please convene or organize a workshop and handhold self-financing colleges about the procedures. Secondly, another suggestion, it is very important. While this is the situation, we find there are Principals who are still not members of the Academic Council. So I request the University administration once the qualifications approval is



accorded all the Principals are to be members of the Academic Council. Automatically they should be members of the Academic Council. This is mainly to ensure all Principals become members of the Academic Council mainly because we need all the Principals to be represented both in the Academic Council and in the Senate.

**The Vice-Chancellor:** With regard to MOU, I welcome the suggestion of Dr. Fathima Vasanth.
