V) INTRODUCTORY REMARKS BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR

Hon'ble Members of the Syndicate and Academic Council.

Good Morning to all of you! I extend a warm welcome to all the Members of this August Body who are present for today's meeting. I also congratulate the newly elected and nominated members for being part of this academic, decision-making body.



It is indeed a great pleasure and honour for me return to the University as the Vice-Chancellor. I the you all for your overwhelming greetings and support

The University Departments and Colleges including Research Institutes are integral par of the University. It is like two sides of the same coin While the University Departments focus on advanced level research besides post-graduate teaching, the Colleges concentrate more on teaching at the undergraduate and post-graduate levels and also contribute to and train the youth to engage in research. Both teaching and research are inseparable. The Affiliated Colleges help us to provide access to higher education to a vast majority of students at affordable cost, without which higher education would not have reached students from rural, poor, and marginalised sections of society. Further, the students of Affiliated Colleges bring laurels to the University in academic and extra-curricular activities. Our academic standing at the National and International Levels depends on the calibre of the graduating students and the quality of our Research. It is my prime objective to enhance the quality of both teaching and research through enriched Curriculum and rigorous research. We should not merely rest on our past glories but continue to hold our pre-eminence and our University should be in the top five educational institutions in the Country. Towards this objective, I have started my work with a ten point agenda which was presented during my first Syndicate Meeting as Vice-Chancellor, which was held on May 29, 2017:



- Enhancing Academic Performance and Institutional Ranking
- Improving Teaching-Learning Activities and improving NAAC score
- Skill Development and Revamping of Courses and Curriculum
- e-Learning through Regular and Distance Learning
- Strengthening Research Activities
- Augmenting Financial Resources
- Student Support Services
- Focus on Placement and Employability
- Green and Clean Campus Initiatives
- Digitalization of administration for Paperless and Cashless Transactions

I earnestly request all of you and also others who are involved in decision-making to keep "Students First" in our thoughts. Our decisions and actions should be centred around this goal. I am confident that such an approach will take us to greater heights. I seek your cooperation, support and suggestion to work as a team to make this University one of the best in the Country.

I would like to briefly summarize the major developments since I have taken charge as the Vice-Chancellor of this University and also my vision and future course of action to achieve the 10-point agenda:



1) 159th Annual Convocation and other Major Events:

In line with our student-centric approach, we have conducted the 159th Annual Convocation and 2016 Supplementary 2015 Annual Convocation and 2016 Supplementary Convocation on July 15, 2017 and awarded degrees to 1216 in person and 1,02,564 in absentia. Thus we have completed the long overdue Convocation and put an end to student's anxiety. I profusely thank you all for the whole-hearted support in conducting the 159th Annual Convocation of our University. Indeed, it was a historic event in which we have awarded Ph.D. degree to 1046 candidates. It was possible because of the support from our Hon'ble Chancellor, Hon'ble Pro-Chancellor and Respected Principal Secretary for Higher Education.

I am also happy to inform this August Body that Professor V. S. Chauhan, Acting Chairman of the UGC and Chairman of the NAAC Executive Committee, visited the University and interacted with faculty members of the University and Principals of the Affiliated Colleges on July 31st 2017.

Another major event took place this week. The Malaysian Government wanted to celebrate "200 years of Tamil Education in Malaysia" in collaboration with our University and this was conducted on a grand scale on September 19th, 2017 with over 2,500 participants. We are happy to be part of the development of Tamil language and culture in Malaysia. I would like to place on record our gratitude to the Government of Tamil Nadu for extending full support and to three of our Hon'ble



Ministers for attending the function along with two of the Hon'ble Ministers of the Malaysian Government. Three Principal Secretaries - Higher Education, School Education and Tamil Development and Information Department - and the Indian High Commissioner to Malaysia were also part of this event.

Post-Centenary Diamond [160 years] Jubilee Celebrations: Yet another major event which we have commenced, with the approval of the Syndicate, is the celebration to mark the completion of 160 years of establishment of the University of Madras. In the 100th year Centenary Celebrations, the then Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru participated and laid the foundation stone for this magnificent building. In the 150th year celebrations, the then President of India Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam inaugurated and the then Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh participated in the Valedictory function. In the same way, we would like to make the 160th year celebration a memorable one.

2. Courses, Curriculum and Student Admission

Ever since I assumed change I have put in my best efforts, to expedite the administrative processes to work fast and bring in overall academic improvement.

Curriculum and Regulations: The Regulations underlying all UG and PG programmes offered in Affiliated Colleges have been consolidated and brought into one document. As you are all aware, the University Departments have been under Common Regulation for



the past two decades and now we have brought out Common Regulation for UG and PG degree programs offered in Affiliated Colleges which will help us in the improve our regulatory mechanism. I thank the improve our regulatory mechanism, of their effort Committee headed by Dean (Academic) for their effort to bring out this document. The Common Regulation we be uploaded in the website and will be circulated to a be uploaded in the website and will be circulated to a Colleges. This will help all those connected with high education system in this country to access on Regulations.

Flexibility in Curriculum and Regulations: A present, students moving from one college to another o going abroad under MoU for one or two semesters and facing a lot of problems. There are not awarded overall CGPA and classification (First, Second, Third class which affects their career. In the Globalised World student mobility is promoted in Universities and Countries across the World. Students should be given an opportunity for such exposure and to gain knowledge. It should be noted that only meritorious students get such opportunities on a competitive basis to go aboard Towards this objective, we plan to change our Regulation to include classification for those students. However, the grades and marks are not comparable across institutions, hence rank will not be given and such students will also not be eligible for prizes and medals based on rank in their degree programme.

XXVI. 12. Resolved that the University be requested that to change the question pattern for the UG Degree. By the existing structure the students did not study the entire syllabus. But they are facing the difficulties in pursuing their higher studies. Hence the question pattern may please be given in the following pattern. Instead of giving 5 out of 8 and 3 out of 5 it may be in the format of 'internal choice' (Either or pattern). Then only students will study the entire syllabus and it is very helpful in pursuing their higher studies.

Dr. M. VENKATRAMANAN As per the existing Regulations, the Pattern of Question Paper for all UG degree courses recommended by all UG Boards of Studies concerned approved by the Academic Council and the Senate; which reads as follows;

UG degree courses, the pattern of question paper: PART-A (50 words): Answer 10 out of 12 Questions $10 \times 2 = 20$ marks

PART-B (200 words): Answer 5 out of 7 Questions $5 \times 5 = 25$ marks

PART-C (500 words): Answer 3 out of 5 Questions 3 x 10 = 30 marks

VII Dr. RITA JOHN moved the following resolutions

Resolved that the University be requested to mention the subject of research as PHYSICS under the title of the thesis for scholars who will be completing their Ph.D. from the Department of Nuclear Physics and the Department of Theoretical Physics under the School of Physical Sciences, University of Madras.

Dr. V. MAHADEVAN As per the existing Ph.D Regulation 10.6 Format of the Degree states as follows:

The Ph.D Degree Certificate shall incorporate the title of the thesis along with the names of the faculty/faculties and disciplines as in Appendices G & G1 (copy enclosed).

In the case of the award of the Ph.D Degree for inter-disciplinary research, the degree certificate shall bear both the subjects of the candidate's post graduate degree and the discipline of the department in which the candidate has conducted his/her doctoral research mentioning them as "inter-disciplinary".

Based on the above Regulations the admission letter of the Ph.D programme will be issued to the candidate by mentioning the discipline of the department as subject.



The Vice-Chancellor: I would like to supplement since this has been an issue. Some of the departments are, at the time of viva-voce examination, passing a resolution in the department committee or in the viva examination that the degree should be given in a different discipline which is not in accordance with the university regulations. So we are not able to accept it. We are going to revise the Ph.D Regulations based on the UGC as well as our existing regulations. We will consider this issue when revising the regulations. We should consider closely related subject as one broad area and award the degree as pointed out by Dr. Rita John. But, anyway it is left to the HOD's, Chariman of Boards of Studies, Chairman of the University Schools to come out with the recommendations which we will consider in the forthcoming Academic Council meeting.

XXVIII. DR. S. BASHEER AHAMED moved the following resolutions

Resolved that the University be requested to extend exemption to the college teachers in the Departments of English, Computer Science, Statistics, Naatya etc. As per the UGC norms, it is mandatory for college teachers to pass the NET/SET exams to be eligible for permanent teaching post. But the University has exempted teachers from this requirement till the year 2014. A request is placed before the University to extend this exemption to the present batch of teachers till they pass NET/SET Examinations.

I am moving this resolution because we have already awarded degrees to many students where teachers with M.Phil have produced graduates.



it is for us to decide whether degrees that we have to the students if it is valued this qualification also be valid. This is my humble request.

Dr. N. SHETTU It is submitted that the Syndicate its meeting held on 11.08.2017 has considered the inutes of the Meeting of the Syndicate Committee on ecognition, Affiliation and Inspection of Colleges held 21.07.2017 with regard to the exemption granted to ne teachers from UGC / NET / SLET / Ph.D handling ubject viz. Computer Science, Media Arts, English, Jatya, Hotel and Catering Management, Interior Design, Management, Work, Mathematics, Social communication & Journalism, Bio-technology, Sio-informatics, Statistics, Yoga, Physical Education and Library for the year 2017-2018 only and resolved as follows:-

> "RESOLVED that the recommendation of the Affiliation Committee meeting held on 21.07.2017 be noted.

RESOLVED FURTHER that atleast 35% of the sanctioned strength of the teachers in the Department of Computer Science, Media Arts, English, Natya, Hotel and Catering Management, Interior Design, Mathematics, Social Work, Management, Communication & Journalism, Bio-technology and Bio-informatics, Statistics, Yoga, Physical Education and Library should have qualified UGC-NET / SLET / Ph.D for the academic year 2017-2018 only"



Further, it is submitted that as per the Resolution passed in the above Syndicate and the same was communicated to all the Principals of the Aided & Self. financing Arts and Science Colleges affiliated to this University.

XXIX & XXX. Mr. EDISON RATHINAM moved the following resolutions

15. Resolved that the University be requested to insist the Boards of Studies to receive suggestions from Heads of Department of all the affiliated colleges to upgrade the syllabi.

Dr.R.THENMOZHI The suggestion regarding addition / deletion of Syllabus received from the faculties / Heads of Departments of all the affiliated Arts and Science Colleges to upgrade the respective Syllabus would be placed before the Boards of Studies concerned for its consideration.

- 16. Resolved that the University be requested to insist the Boards of Studies to perform upgradation of the syllabi for every 4 or 5 years with respect to currently trending technologies and the industry requirements.
- Dr. G. Ravindran A D.O. Letter.No.9-2/2017 (CPP-II) on 31st January 2017 received from the University Grant Commission has recommended that, the curricula of all Academic Departments in Universities should be reviewed and revised at least once in every three years. This review and revision of academic curricula should focus on the existing and potential demand and supply of skill sets to make the University and College students employable.



The Syndicate at its meeting held on 11th August has considered the above UGC recommendation of resolved as follows;

"RESOLVED that the recommendation of the UGC that the performance of all academic departments in Universities should be reviewed at least once in every three years and the academic curricula should focus on the existing and potential demand and supply of skill sets to make the University/Colleges students employable, be accepted."

"RESOLVED ALSO that the above items be referred to all UG/PG Chairpersons of the Boards of Studies to consider and incorporate in the Regulations and Syllabus".

As per the above decision of the Syndicate, the matter has to be referred to all UG and PG Chairpersons of Boards of Studies concerned for taking further action.

XXXI. T. BALACHANDAR moved the following resolutions.

- Resolved that the University be requested to replace the Business Taxation / Indirect Taxes subjects by newly updated GST in UG and PG Courses.
- Dr. S. May I request this body to consider this request once again?

Dr. K. Jothi Sivagnanam: Sir, the Resolution and Iohn Dr. C. Venkateswaran, they have got a serious problem including the Nuclear Physics. Even the teachers could not go to Foreign Countries. Foreigners are looking at it differently. It comes under the same School.

We will consult the The Vice-Chancellor: Chairpersons of all the schools and then decide how to specify the name of the discipline in which the degree is to be awarded. If all the departments of a school agree, we have no problem in awarding the degree in the conventional nomenclature.

Plagiarism I request the University like other Universities to provide direct facilities to access for all the faculty members to log in and put all the reports, projects they have to get direct access and not through COE's office. It will be messy. Already lot of work there. We should not go and put reports etc., initially it shows 3% sometimes, if they have not deleted the previous, it will be a lot of confusion and it shows 80% so we have to go for like Central Universities Pondicherry. Otherwise it would be major hurdles for the faculty members. I, therefore, request you to install any alternative packages providing for the faculties to access plagiarism about students in UG, PG, M.Phil, Ph.D and other reports.

The Vice-Chancellor: The existing arrangement is that after completing the Ph.D thesis, a copy is given to COE's office to check for plagiarism. We are using the free software given by UGC, URKUND. If the thesis is already put through, URKUND, it stores the information and the plagiarism check conducted by the COE's Office would show very high level of plagiarism. That is why we are suggesting that our students and teachers do not put the thesis in the plagiarism check software before they submit the thesis. The students are given a chance to relook the part in which plagiarism is deducted. If the student and Supervisor assure that there is no plagiarism, we accept the thesis.



I think this facility gives an opportunity for the teachers and students to revise and resubmit the thesis. As stated by Dr. S. Manivasakan, we will extend this As stated by Dr. S. Manivasakan, we will extend this facility to our M.Phil and M.A Students so that facility to our M.Phil and M.A Students so that plagiarism will be prevented at the entry level. XXXVI. Dr. K. Thirusangu: Honble Chairman, Respected Registrar-in-charge and members of this August House, almost all the courses are conducted in semester mode. As far as M.Phil course is concerned you have given time to admit students till 31st August and the examinations are again conducted in the next year August and the dissertations are allowed to submit upto October and then declaring the results. An almost student has to spend two academic years. Examinations may be conducted atleast in May and the students can get their degrees at the earliest. This is my humble submission to this house.

The Vice-Chancellor: It is not correct M.Phil admission is usually completed by August 31st and the dissertation has to be submitted by next year 30th November without penalty.

XXXVII. Dr. (Mrs) Hanifa Ghosh: Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, hon'ble Registrar i/c and members of this August Body. I want to talk about one particular issue



Affiliation. We are happy with the vision of the Vice-Chancellor making our University as one of the best five India. But at the sometime I think we should look into the problems of the Affiliated Colleges. Many Colleges are facing a lot of problems because we are not able to get permanent affiliation. We have fulfilled all the norms and we have satisfied all the requirements, we have been waiting for a very long time but we have not heard anything. As a result we are finding it difficult even to get and 12-b recognition and even Autonomy. I therefore request you to look into the matter.

The Vice-Chancellor: So far, there are very few cases pending for granting Permanent Affiliation. That too because some certificates are not submitted. We assure you that it will be granted without undue delay.

Chairman, Registrar i/c, COE i/c and my dear members of the August Body with regard to Plagiarism that I would like to clarify, have you got any period specified for the plagiarism should be there or not. Suppose you identified the plagiarism after awarding degree what would be action taken on that. I want the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to please give us the period about it secondly, Dr. Rita John Physics is concerned it not only in Physics but also in many subjects. You take up B.Com Corporate Accounting and Finance, B.Com Corporate Secretaryship and so on and M.Com and so on. Even the nomenclature would be Commence and the concerned subject would be mentioned on that.

The Vice-Chancellor: Under existing regulations, even after award of Ph.D Degree, we have the power to withdraw the degree, if any plagiarism is found in the thesis. But we cannot take up all past theses for



plagiarism check. Regarding the nomenclature, as I said in my introductory remarks, students are facing lot of problems. Very often requests come from TNPSC to establish equivalence, even though we are awarding degrees based on the UGC norms. I would request the Chairman, Boards of Studies of interdisciplinary courses to meet with the conventional course Boards of Studies Chairman and sort out the problem. As per the TNPSC Criteria, 75% of the core course must be same with the existing TNPSC Programme.

XXXIX. Dr. G. Ravindran: Respected Chairperson and Members of the Academic Council, there is one word in English which has no substitute, when you like someone's aims and policies, they say in Europe "KUDOS" I am delighted after so many years of struggle we have expressed in the same hall. I am delighted to be present in this meeting for several reasons. For the first time we have something like hand book which indicates that there is commonality in terms of Regulations. Nobody thought about it. Everybody was talking but not in reality. Congratulations. This is the way to go and if we are going to have this clarity in supporting the Vice-Chancellor I think the Vice-Chancellor's dream of getting highest possible rank not within five levels but even the first rank is possible. Congratulations, I see clarity in his approach because ever since he assumed office he is very clear about one thing i.e. falling in time with bench mark and as determined by MHRD and UGC and his 10 point vision you have done wonderful thing, meaning full thing, in this Academic Council by including UGC's Regulations for M.Phil and Ph.D. I have one suggestion we have to also adopt four amendments of the common standards of UGC Regulations 2010. This house has not adopted since 2010. The recent one is the Common Minimum Standard fourth amendment 2016. I am sure that you will adopt it in the coming meetings. The second



important piece of UGC Regulations 2016 has come out.

My concern is how we are going to have MoUs etc. I My request our Vice-Chancellor to consider that also.

The Vice-Chancellor: We adopted 2010 Minimum standards of Qualifications for appointment of teachers in the Affiliated Colleges and Universities and adopt all four amendments to 2010 Regulations. UGC's 2016 Regulations on qualification for appointment of teachers will be out soon and we will follow the new regulation for those qualify for promotion from January 1st 2016 onwards depending upon transitory provision in the Regulations.

V. G. Vijayalakshmi: Respected XL. Dr. Chairperson and Members of the August Body, regarding the issue raised by Dr. T. Balachander, Business Taxation should be replaced with new act called Service Act. I think even the Central Excise Department should be called as GST Department because now the TNGST, CST, Service Tax, Additional Tax which are all no more existing. It is being replaced by on ACT GST. It is in all Commerce subjects. As Dr. Venkataraman pointed out it has come with different names it is common to Commerce subjects with different names Management which is coming for the fourth semester of B.Com and first semester of M.Com but it may be varied from one semester to another sometimes in other Commerce subjects since the new Act comes these are all not in existence. I referred to the Boards of Studies they are also drafting a paper called GST.

The Vice-Chancellor: we will ask the Commerce Board to look into it, and incorporate and bring it to the next Academic Council.



Vice-Chancellor, Respected Registrar, the COE and the Thiru, J. Gandhiraj: Members of the Academic Council, good evening to everybody. I am happy that handbook on UG Common Regulations has given by the University. But in the fifth page of the UGC Regulations offered for the Affiliated Arts and Science Colleges for workload in the instructional hours it was given 4+2 for language with star for 2 hours and in the English 4+2 with asterisk Under that it was given for star two hours for part IV basic Tamil/Advanced Tamil/Non-Major Courses and for two hours under asterisk for Soft Skill Courses. Our College teachers are of the opinion that 6 hours has been reduced to 4 hours. We want to clarify from University, two hours given has to be engaged by whom and which teachers if we are given clarity then there will not be any confusion at all. What type of mechanism you are going to evolve? Secondly for the panel for examiners for Ph.D there was a letter received by guide in which it has been stated "I am by direction to request you submit fresh panel of international list from high ranking reputed University. Kindly clarify which are all high ranking University.

The Vice-Chancellor: We have not changed the hours of teaching and this has been adopted from the existing regulation which has already been accepted by the colleges. The Panel of examiners given by some guides for Ph.D evaluation are not acceptable and so we ask for a fresh Panel of examiners.

XLII. Dr. R. Ramesh Kumar: Respected Chairman, Respected Registrar, COE and members of the Academic Council. I am a new member for this Forum. I would like to offer a small suggestion. We have been coming across lot of changes in the curriculum and trends like GST. I request the Vice-Chancellor to have a



Symposia/Workshop in collaboration with University so as to facilitate Affiliated Colleges by Providing some technical support etc. this is my humble request.

Dr. N. Mathivanan: Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Respected Registrar and members of this Academic Body, good evening. Because of time,. I do not want to talk much. However, I will briefly tell 4 points which I have observed. First regarding Syllabus it is revised. But if you look at the reference and text books, it has not been updated. Some of the books which have been there for the past 10 years. So we need to give updated reference books atleast recent books so that we can achieve academic excellence. Secondly, years are not there. How they can go and find out the books?. I therefore, request the Vice-Chancellor to give direction to the Boards of Studies to take care of the small mistakes because we are approving the Syllabus, this is a matter of quality. Thirdly, I want to emphasise with regard to plagiarism. In science subjects like Botany, certain words ie., Plants name will be repeatedly occurring in many places. Botanical names wherever you go throughout the world it is same likewise research in biodiversity in western Ghats and Easter Ghats plants names are the same. If we record in the thesis in many places the names will be reflected. If you need the software it will show some 20% plagiarism. In that case by case you can invite the attention of the Board of Studies.

Recently, I came across a case which I request the Vice-Chancellor to take care of this coming to Viva examination. One examiner should be a person who evaluated the thesis. Even in the previous meeting Prof. G. Ravindiran has pointed out that University is insisting to give examiners panel from Chennai city. We are finding it very difficult to identify specialist is



particular specialization. Then we are compromising to invite expert from Chennai city and it is a kind of formality. If you consider the quality point of view we should be allowed to invite from other states that will give us an opportunity for cross talking so that we could know what type of research is going on elsewhere also.

The Vice-Chancellor: About the references and updating of the Syllabus, it is the responsibility of the Updating of the Syllabus, it is the responsibility of the Chairman of the Board of Studies to see that current developments are incorporated. Now, we have reconstituted the Boards of Studies. We will ask all the Chairmen to pay attention and include recent references etc. About the plagiarism as I said earlier we must find out where this is happening. If there is no plagiarism, we accept the thesis. We cannot refer every case to the Board of Studies.


XLIII. Dr. A. Joseph Durai: Respected Chairman, Registrar and hon'ble members, I would like to point out that in the Regulations in page 22 where classification Part-I, Part-II, Part-IV and Part-V has been given. Now in the new revised Syllabus for the Environmental Studies Programme it has been mentioned as ability enhancement computer course which is not in our frame work. If you see the UGC Regulations 2015-2016 classification was given as core course, Genetic Course, Skill Enhancement Course, Ability Enhancement Course. Without classification, we are bringing Enhancement Course in this framework. Secondly our college has also applied for Permanent Affiliation and awaiting orders.

The Vice-Chancellor: We will update the Environmental Course with the new course.




XLIV. Dr. M. Abdul Rahim: Respected Chairman and hon'ble members, this is regarding Item No.11.1. welcome the good decision of the University to implement the UGC Guidelines especially reducing the percentage of marks for certain category of students. Actually this will help the students from socially weaker sections. Sir, we have already completed the admission for M.Phil course. We do have applications from SC/ST or those who have got more than 50% and less than 55% marks this year. Every some of the students they got through the entrance examinations also. But we have not admitted those students this year because at the time of admission our University has not implemented the UGC guidelines. Now there are few seats vacant due to various reasons in some of the M.Phil programs. I request the University that students who have denied their opportunity otherwise eligible should be allowed to admit in the current year itself. I raise this issue based on two reasons. 1) This implementation of the UGC guidelines was already published in the Government of India Gazette on 5th May 2016 itself. But we are implementing now only. Students who have already passed the postgraduate course in 2016 already denied their chance in our University and again this year denied their chance. It is almost two years. They are going to waste. 2) Another reason even in our colleges M.Phil student submit thesis in September in the subsequent year of admission. They will have one full year duration. You can allow the students in the present academic year itself. This exemption is applicable only for those who have already applied and denied as a special case. Kamaraj Madurai thing. Another implemented well in advance. Because of all these reasons. I once again request the University to consider my request and allow the students to be admitted in the current academic year.

III. INTRODUCTORY REMARKS BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR

Hon'ble Members of the Syndicate and Academic Council!

Good Morning and a warm welcome to the Members of this August Body. Join me in welcoming the newly elected and nominated members and also Dr R. Srinivasan, our Registrar. I seek your active participation in the democratic decision making process.

Let me begin by updating you on the work done since the last Academic Council Meeting and the proposed initiatives to be taken up in the coming months for the overall development of the University, and affiliated colleges and institutions.

I would like to assure the members of this August Body that the University of Madras has not violated any rule/regulation set by the regulatory bodies such as UGC while introducing new courses, programmes



in regular or distance education or approving new study centres. I have been maintaining a high level of transparency, arriving at consensus in critical issues and following democratic process in decision making. Rule based administration and 'students' interest first' are the guiding principles of our administration.

I. Academic

- i. As I announced in the last Academic Council meeting, we have introduced flexibility in core courses by modifying the existing regulation and curriculum in CBCS to make it learner friendly and to improve the academic standards. I hope the Autonomous and Nonautonomous Colleges will also follow suit and provide wider choice in courses offered to the students.
- A major revision of courses and curriculum of the University departments has been undertaken and placed for the approval of this August Body.
- iii. Necessary changes in the regulations have been brought in to take up MOCCs courses offered through SWAYAM platform for all the academic degree programmes offered through the University departments, affiliated colleges and IDE. This will make way for a larger number of courses and expand the choice available to students.
- iv. Centre for Web based learning. The University will establish a new centre exclusively to develop on-line courses that will become part of MOXCs programme and also to introduce degree programmes.
- v. On-Line Courses and Programmes: We have brought in regulations based on UGC Regulation for on-line programmes 2017 to offer degree, diploma and certificate programmes with the approval of the UGC

from the academic year 2018-19. Our experience in offering Pan-African e-learning programme is an added advantage.

- vi. Some of our PG degree programmes will be offered through three modes of delivery regular teaching through the departments, distance education with e-learning materials, and web based on-line programmes. I envisage that all our degree programmes will be made available through these three modes in the near future, thus enhancing access to higher education -anyone, anytime and anywhere. This is the technology which is going to rule academic institutions in the foreseeable future. The University of Madras should be the leader in adopting new technology and introducing innovative curriculum.
- A two-day orientation programme for Principals on MOOCs and recent advances in teaching-learning technology was organised.
- viii. I am happy to inform you that the University has entered into a MoU with the NSDL to digitise our certificates and make them available through National Academic Depository (NAD). All students and employers can access the marks sheets, degree and other certificates through the NAD.
- ix. We have reconstituted most of the Board of Studies (BOS) and the new BoS will work to bring in enriched curriculum and include recent advances in the syllabi.
- II. Institute of Distance Education
 We have initiated several new measures to improve the administration
 and quality of the programmes.



- I am pleased to inform you that the NCTE has granted permission to start B. Ed degree programme in IDE with effect from 2018-19.
- All BOS of IDE have been reconstituted and the meeting of the Boards were convened to revise the syllabus based on the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for IDE.
- iii, We have planned to expand our IDE programme so as to reach larger sections of society. Towards this objective, an interaction meeting was held with the College Principals and they have been requested to establish a Learner Support Centre to offer our degree, certificate and diploma programmes.
- A handbook of regulations for UG and PG courses of IDE, similar to the one developed for Affiliated Colleges, has been prepared.
- v. An in-house software development for IDE management (admission, fee payment & examination) by the e-governance centre has been initiated.
- vi. The hand-written challan based payment system is completely eliminated and students are now using the on-line payment system or across the bank counter through system generated payment slip.

III. Research

Research occupies the highest priority in the University's academic activities. We have been working hard to improve the quality of our research programmes (M.Phil. /Ph.D. /D.Litt. D.Sc., D.L.L.) and research projects through several initiatives:



- I. The University has revised the regulations for M.Phil. and Ph.D. based on the UGC Regulations 2016 and the revised regulations are placed for approval of this August Body. The admission, examination and evaluation of these research programmes will be streamlined.
- H. All major research schemes UGC-UPE, CAS, SAP, 12th Plan, DST-PURSE, FIST, & DBT-BOSTER and RUSA schemes have been periodically reviewed to expedite the research progress and utilisation of the grant. The University has received Rs. 5 crores under the DST-PURSE programme and Rs. 2.72 crores under the UGC 12th Five Plan scheme.
- iii. The suspended 5 research programmes under UPE including the preparation of a multi-lingual dictionary by the departments of Indian languages have been revived and research proposals selected for funding.
- The office of Research Schemes and Projects (RSP) has been modernised.
- v. A training programme for staff and faculty members was organised on Public Finance Management System (PFMS) of the Gol. All schemes and projects will be uploaded in the PFMS from March 2018 as required by the funding agencies.

The Vice-Chancellor: As I said in the introductory remarks, the students' interest always comes first. In this case, we were allowing the students to register for examinations from 08.09.2017 to 14.9.2017 with penalty but the college approached us only on 7.11.2017, almost two months after registration. This cannot be allowed as it will be an endless process of allowing students to register for examination. We have one and half lakh students from affiliated colleges appearing for the examination every semester and the University administration cannot be burdened with the mistakes of the colleges. We request you to report corrections in the Hall Ticket within one week from the last date so that, we shall set right the records ahead of the

2017-2018

representation of examinations. Rule 8 is for distance education and cannot ps applied to regular college courses.

Dr. Hanifa Ghosh: Small suggestion sir regarding the data entry, as MJain College principle mentioned, like Neet IIT, IEE applications corrections on be carried out before a particular date. Statement State compigned agreement or particular date Garadaga rectify union point candilly fig. easyallan upapular statings and great at suggestion sir.

The Vice-Chancellor: Good suggestion. The colleges can carry out orrections before the last date. If brought to our notice within one or two days after last date we will correct it.

Dr. R. Anuradha: I wish to bring to your notice the results of the examination that we received a week ago. It is a disaster because in our effeges there are bright students who received only 2 marks in external. We have made representations to the controller but the students have been asked apply for revaluation. I feel this is gross in-justice, because the students have to pay Rs. 1000 for revaluation. There are atleast 100 good students who have failed in the external examination. I wish to bring this to your notice.

The Vice-Chancellor: We have received about 15,000 revaluation requests and in about 50%, there is no change in the result. We also have a povision for retotalling. The students can request for a photo copy of their answer scripts. The examination system of our University is the most sansparent and no one can deny this.

If the candidate was successful in revaluation 50% of money was refunded. Why don't you start again the same procedure in revaluation?

The Vice-Chancellor: Can we collect it from the remuneration of the teachers who have valued the answers papers and refund the students?

Dr. A. Joseph Durai: Respected Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and August body. I as a principal, on behalf of the principals, I thank Vice-Chancellor for conducting two day programme for us about the MOOC courses. It was an enlightening course. One thing from the talk with NPTEL person which observed was the title of the course to be left open. It should not be specified because most of the courses are not re-run, so what is in the course in this program, will not be in the next semester. So while going through semester appendix given title mentioned in the MOOC courses offered I think title of the courses should not be mentioned this is for information. Regarding these content development I think college teachers also should included in developing content for online courses, our teachers who are in colleges should be encouraged to write this content. Now the third aspect regarding condonation date and detention date, I think should to be left to colleges University should not fix the condonation because we have 20 to 25 days working days before the which we cannot fix the condonation or detention. The previous practice of condonation and detention and articles stage should be followed because there are students on the marginal level, look out for 20

The Vice-Chancellor. Regarding MOOCs, we have made a provision that before the commencement of a semester, the Head of the Department and School Chairperson will recommend the courses to be included under MOOCs for that semester. Similarly for the Affiliated colleges, the Principals on recommend courses which can be considered under MOOCs and the Chairman, Board of Studies can be asked to consider and recommend to the University for approval.

The University will give approval before the commencement of the semester. It is not necessary to come back to the Academic Council for approval of these recommended courses.

Dr.V.Lakshmipathy: Respected Chairman Sir and honorable August body members. A small request sir, we have already uploaded the model question papers and previous years question papers in the website. My numble request is you should also upload syllabi of new courses for affiliated humble request is you should also upload syllabi of all the courses

The Vice-Chancellor: We will upload the syllabi of all the courses approved by the University of Madras before the commencement of semester.

Dr. Elangovan Vellaichamy: Respected Chairman sir and honorable August body members, the item No. 13.20 changes made in the core course are confusing and this has been done in very hurried manner. We need some time to understand the idea. There are changes in the soft skill courses, now we have to depend on the online courses.

The Vice-Chancellor: I will answer and clarify that.

Dr. Elangovan Vellaichamy: But still we need some more time to adjust to the new regulations.

The Vice-Chancellor: This new regulation was introduced only in January and of course you need time to revise the course list and syllabus. We can make necessary changes in the courses and bring it to the next meeting of the Academic Council for ratification. The MOOC's shall be specified one month before the commencement of the semester. The colleges need to send the list of prescribed MOOC's. The Syndicate will approve these courses.

About the soft skill courses offered by the University Departments, it is left to the Departments or the Schools to offer courses relevant to the particular subject. You can take time and revise the content. We will ratify it.

Dr. P.K. Abdul Rahiman: Honorable Vice-Chancellor and the members of the August bodies. I want to record my concern related to Agenda 13. I don't know how many of you aware of fact that in Government colleges you only collect Rs. 900 plus as a fees for UG students and Rs. 1100/- plus for the PG students, Rs.20,000 as fee for Re-do courses is very high. Rs. 20,000/- may not be a big amount for us according to our salary, but we know the students suffer to pay their normal exam fee. Many students are not able to pay the normal exam fee of Rs.700 or Rs. 800/- So, please reconsider this and immediately just try to abolish this resolution sir. Thank you.



pr. S. Basheer Ahmed: We are worried about the students but at the time we have to take care of the examiners also who take pains in coming to the examination centers on time to evaluate the papers. Secondly, one more clarification which I would like to ask here. We talk about 75% of attendance of the students without condonation. There are some autonomous colleges where they detain the students even after securing 80% of the attendance. Kindly, look into the matters and do justice for the students. Thank you.

The Vice-Chancellor: Thanks for specific comments we will definitely examine that and take necessary action.

Dr N. Kala: Honorable Chairman, Registrar and the members of the August bodies, Sir the proposal have been from our Department centre for Cyber Forensic to convert the M.Sc., course into partly self supportive and partly regular but it is not been listed.

The Vice-Chancellor: We will make necessary corrections, we will approve that the M.Sc Cyber Forensics is partly self-supportive and partly regular.

Dr. V.G. Vijayalakshmi: Respected Chairperson, Registrar and the members of the August bodies, I just to want to put forth the difficulties that we face in the even semester. We have our exams conducted till 6th of becember then from 14th of December we have 14 days spent on valuation. December then from 14th of December we have 14 days spent on valuation.
