We are very happy that this would be the third year that we shall be working together for the cause of the downtrodden and look forward to being of service to the beneficiaries. For your ready reference, I would like to furnish details of our free training -

This Social Initiative of Tata Consultancy Services Ltd (TCS) aims to improve the employability of SC/ST and underprivileged students of Arts & Sciences . This is an integral part of our Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) role from 2010 onwards and we have identified key areas of concern which inhibit otherwise meritorious SC/ST and underprivileged students from getting good jobs in the corporate scenario.

Therefore, we train these graduates in English Communication Skills, Basic Corporate Etiquette and for entrance tests which would make them improve in these areas and make them employable. The beneficiaries are able to vastly increase their self-confidence and interview performance ability as a consequence of our training. 
IPv6 is the sixth revision to the Internet Protocol and the successor to IPv4, It functions similarly to IPv4 in that it provides the unique, numerical IP addresses necessary for Internet-enabled devices to communicate. However, it does sport one major difference; it utilizes 128-bit addresses.

LAN switching is a form of packet switching in which the data packets are transferred from one computer to another over a network.


