



10. Excess admission shall never be made to any course over and above to the sanctioned strength of the respective course[s];

11. The Management of the College shall not discontinue any existing course without prior permission from the University which should be intimated before the 30th September.

12. The College shall only collect Tuition and other fees from the students at the rates as prescribed by the State Government / University;

13. In the interest of standard of P.G. Education, the guidelines prescribed by the University for the P.G. Courses shall be followed. The admission to P.G. Courses will be considered on the guidelines determined by the Syndicate from time to time;

14. The guidelines with regard to infrastructure required for conducting the B.Sc.Computer Science course and qualifications for the teaching staff should be strictly adhered to;

15. The College should have [1] separate lounge [2] Rest room [3] Toilet [4] Women Faculty etc.,

16. A Librarian, Physical Director/Directress and a Medical Officer with the prescribed qualification shall be appointed.

17. Number of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be appointed as per norms prescribed by the University/ U.G.C./ Government for each course including foundation course, allied and application oriented subjects;

18. No teacher shall be appointed, if he has not fulfilled the qualifications as laid down by the University and U.G.C. from time to time;

19. Teaching and Non-teaching staff shall be paid as per pay scales of State Government / U.G.C. prescribed from time to time;

20. An agreement shall be entered into with each teacher to be appointed as per the requirements of the University/ Tamilnadu Private Colleges(Regulation) Act and rules thereunder;

21. The posts of teacher and Head of Departments wherever required for the proposed course shall be filled up before starting the course;

22. No teacher shall be appointed or shall be continued in service, who has attained the age of superannuation as may be prescribed by the Tamilnadu Government;



23. Suitable leave rules for teachers and Non-teaching staff be amended, generally in conformity with the State Government rules;

24. Approval shall be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff;

25. All conditions of affiliation laid down in Chapter XXVI Laws of the University Calendar, Volume-1 1985 as amended shall be strictly followed;


26. Such other Rules and Regulations as may be generally prescribed from time to time by the University shall also be complied with;

27. If all the conditions of Provisional affiliation granted are not complied with by the end of the period fixed then affiliation or approval shall cease automatically;

I am, also to inform you that provisional affiliation to the above said course(s) granted to your college, for the academic year 2001-2002 will not be extended further (i.e. for the academic year 2002-2003) until and unless all the above conditions are satisfied in full. If the conditions are not fulfilled by the end of the academic year 2001-2002 as per Statute 44-A of Chapter XXVI of the Laws of the University Calendar Volume 1, 1985, the provisional affiliation granted for the above said course[s] will cease automatically and will not be extended for the next academic year (i.e. for 2002-2003).
