and decided that permission for starting the said College with provisional affiliation for the courses mentioned hereunder be granted for the academic year 2001-2002 only, subject to the conditions of affiliation stipulated in this regard and subject to availability sufficient classrooms and procurement of Library books recommended by the Inspection Commission and as per the stipulations of the University and also subject to the specifif condition that the Management is permitted to start the College with 1 year Classes temporarily in the Buildings exclusively set apart in St.Michael's Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Adyar, Chennai for the academic year 2001-2002 only with the condition that there should be no mingling of College and School Classrooms. The Management should construct a Permanent Building for the College at the 3 acres of land purchased at-Kottur, Adyar, Chennai 20 in the name of the College and the College should be shifted to the permanent buildings before commencement of the next academic year 2002-2003. The above said land should not be utilised for any purpose other than the above College purpose as per G.O.Ms.No.168 Higher Education [El] Department, dated 20th April 2001. :
