The Civil Services Information Cell and PCEC jointly organized an Orientation Program for all Civil Service aspirants on 29 January 2015. Prof. D. Stalin, Director, Eva Stalin IAS Academy, Chennai was the Guest Speaker. The Students from different departments registered. The objective of the program was to make the students aware of various stages in Civil Services Examination and methods of preparation.

Prof. D. Stalin gave detailed information about the stages in civil services exam. He explained to the students about the marks allotted for the preliminary, main and personality test. Valuable insight was given into the selection of Optional Syllabus, effective use of question papers, selection of books, preparing the notes and specific strategy to preparefor.



## **THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2016-17**

PCEC conducted civil services orientation for the aspirants for the students. The chief guest for the day was Thiru S. Nagarajan Director e governance and the national topper in UPSC examination. Several students took part in the programme. A special talk on how to gather information on current affairs and general knowledge from magazine and news papers was also given. An orientation for All India Civil Services Coaching Centre (AICSCC) entrance examination was conducted on 24th August, 2017. It offers free coaching for civilservices aspirants with residential facility. The chief guest Dr. G. Gowthaman, Principal (i/c) AICSCC oriented the civil services aspirants about various examinations conducted by the UPSC, various Civil Services listed under the UPSC, eligibility criteria, selection process, paper pattern – preliminary, main, coaching modalities of AICSCC and gave model question papers for AICSCC entrance examination. Around 500 civil services aspirants participated in the program.

TNPSC CCSE – GROUP IV coaching program for Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission aspirants was inaugurated on 24th November 2017, to kindle competitive spirit among aspirants towards competitive examinations. The Chief Guest Mr. P. Angamuthu, Director, VSB coaching centre counseled the aspirants on the importance of choosing a carrier as a government servant and the wide spectrum of scope open thereafter. Memory techniques, short-cuts for aptitude questions, cut-off marks for qualifying the examination are the other areas dealt by him. An intensive coaching program for TNPSC CCSE GROUP – IV commenced from 30th November 2017 to 9<sup>th</sup> February 2018, around 70 aspirants were made competent to face the TNPSC CCSE GROUP – IV examination.

The training program was inauguration by Prof. James Raaj, Head, Department of English, SRM University on 20<sup>th</sup> Sept 2017.
