

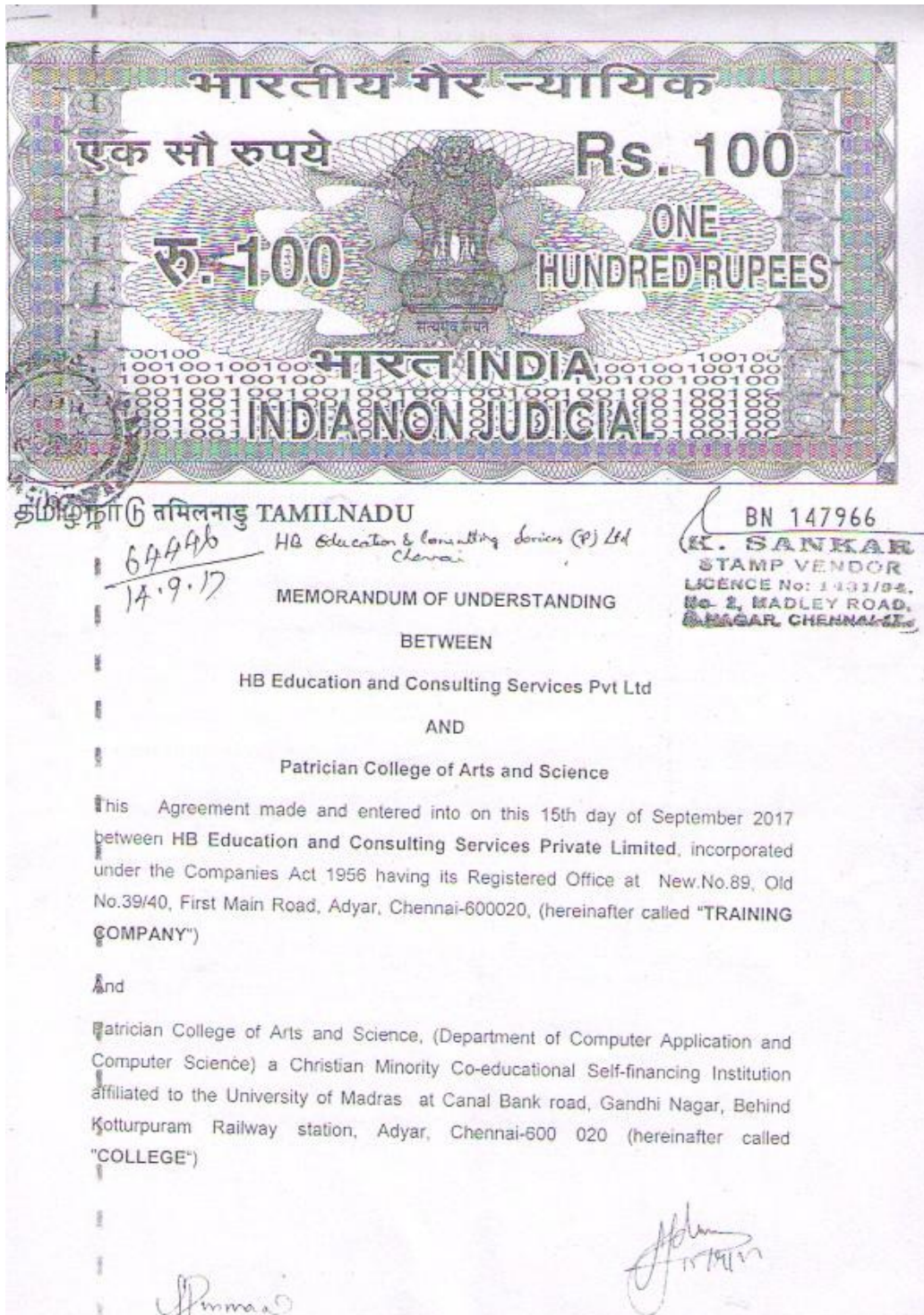

Memorandum of Understanding

4. The Agency will provide Resource Persons from their own organisation or from any their partnering organisations.



II. The College agrees to:

1. Send the name of each student before the beginning date of the Concurrent field work/internship.
2. Make available students for campaigns, projects and programmes organised by the Agency as per the feasibility of the College, mutually agreed upon.
3. Make available faculty members to discuss with the designee of the Agency, regarding the assignment to be assumed by the student in the Internship program.

III. Patrician College of Arts & Science and the Ministro Foundation, Chennai mutually agrees that:

1. The Agency will have nominal fees in the College or students for the use of the Agency's resources in connection with this training program/Concurrent field work/Internship.
2. They will jointly organise Seminars, Workshops, Conferences and Training programmes.
3. They will jointly carry out publications, as mutually agreed.
4. They will implement campaigns, programmes and projects, as mutually decided.
5. They will conduct joint certificate course as and when the need arises, as per mutual agreement.


IV. Terms of Agreement:

This MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING (MoU) is made and executed at Chennai on 9th day of December, 2017;

1. Background:

The Second Party is of the opinion that the First Party has the necessary qualifications, experience and abilities to provide services to the Second Party.

The First Party is agreeable to providing such services to the Second Party on the terms and conditions set out in this Agreement.

IN CONSIDERATION OF the matters described above and of the mutual benefits and obligations set forth in this Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, the First Party and the Second Party agree as follows:

Services Provided

1. The Second Party hereby agrees to engage the First Party to provide the Second Party with services consisting of:
 - Providing the Guest Lectures once in every month and Internship to the students of Psychology Department of Second Party whenever needed.
2. The Services will also include any other tasks which both the Parties may agree on.

Compensation

For the services rendered by the First Party as required by this Agreement, the Second Party will grant the First Party:

- The infrastructure facilities for conducting training programs for students from various colleges and institutions whenever needed.
- The enrollment of the students of Second Party for the training program conducted at the venue of Second Party


Specific activities under this MOU will be identified through consultation between both the parties. Both the parties agree to cooperate with each other in possible means for providing the services till the agreed time period.

2. General Terms of MOU

2.1 Duration of MOU: This MOU shall be operational on signing and will have an initial duration of one academic year (November 2017 to April 2018). All activities conducted before this date within the vision of the joint collaboration will be deemed to fall under this agreement.

2.2 Coordination: In order to carryout and fulfill aims of this agreement, each party will appoint an appropriate person(s) to represent its organization and to coordinate the implementation of referral and consultation. A regular meeting will be conducted to discuss the progress and further plans.

2.3 Confidentiality: Each party agrees that it shall not, at any time, after executing the activities of this MOU, disclose any information in relation to these activities or affairs of this business or method of carrying on the business of the other without the consent of both the parties.

2.4 Extension and termination of MOU: The partnership covered by this MOU shall initially terminate upon completion of the agreed time period. However, provided both the parties agree, the agreement can be extended. The agreement can be terminated with a written one month notice from either side. In the event of noncompliance or breach of this MOU by any party, the other party may terminate this MOU with immediate effect.


3. Other Provisions

- Both the parties hold the right to review the nature and effectiveness of the services offered by both the parties.
- Both the parties promise to consider one another as the primary source of reference.
- The contract shall be renewed every 1 year.
- The contract can be dissolved by any of the parties when the services are not satisfactory or the confidentiality of the case is not maintained or for any payment related issues with prior notice and discussion.
- In providing the Services under this Agreement it is expressly agreed that the First Party is acting as an independent contractor and not as an employee.
- Any amendment or modification of this Agreement or additional obligation assumed by either Party in connection with this Agreement will only be binding if evidenced in writing signed by each Party or an authorized representative of each Party.
- The First Party will not voluntarily or by operation of law assign or otherwise transfer its obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Second Party.
- It is agreed that there is no representation, warranty, collateral agreement or condition affecting this Agreement except as expressly provided in this Agreement.
