

PLACEMENT REPORT 2018-19

The campus placement process for the Patrician College of Arts and Science Class of 2019, witnessed an excellent season with most of the students already placed as on 15 March 2019. Each year, we invite and host companies on campus to hold recruitments for our students apart from the annual Job Fair conducted by the college. This year our college's placement witnessed an excellent season with 78% increase in students placed in 2019 when compared to the previous year.

We aim to invite companies from various fields in order to make opportunities available for the students belonging to all streams of study. Source Hub acts as an interface between the students of the college and various companies that liaise with the college for recruitment. This time, Source Hub team also conducted a survey after the orientation to clearly identify students who are interested for campus interviews as compared to those interested in managing their own business or pursuing higher studies. 50% of 685 students showcased interest in campus interviews and the remaining opted for other options.


Like the previous years, the cell organized several workshops for students this year as well. The seminar on Soft skills Development and Career Building held in the campus proved highly valuable and appropriate for most of the final year students who would be taking part in group discussions, interviews and campus drives in the near future. 10 different types of training sessions were conducted throughout the year which varied from conducting mock interviews, online aptitude tests from NIIT, written tests, placement readiness workshops, TOEFL seminar and other sessions.

NIIT Foundation organized a week long placement training inside the campus for the arrear students which includes WPPF (Whole Person Process Facilitation) and Change Maker Student (CMS) Rollout. Certificates were provided after the completion of the course. We also tied up with Tata Consultancy Services to create industry awareness for Science students in their areas of specialization. The program, codenamed "TCS – Ignite" helped in our success.



To make students well equipped with the company processes, Source Hub has managed to arrange an Industrial Visit for the students to Wipro. Other Seminars and Mock interview sessions were conducted for the final year students to make them proficient in reasoning abilities.

The placement season this year saw participation from major recruiters like Wipro, IndusInd Bank, RR Donnelley, TCS, Sutherland, Sundaram Finance, Just Dial, Zilker Technology, Infosys, Adecco, Website Learners to name a few. This year a total of 207 students got placed. Students were offered various coveted roles in Analytics, Consulting, Ecommerce, Banking and Technology Consulting.


