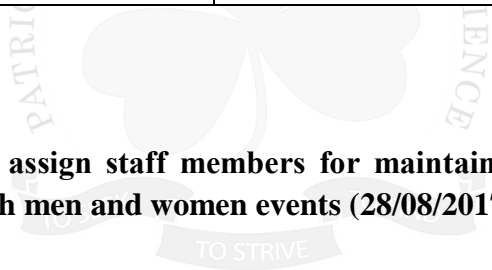

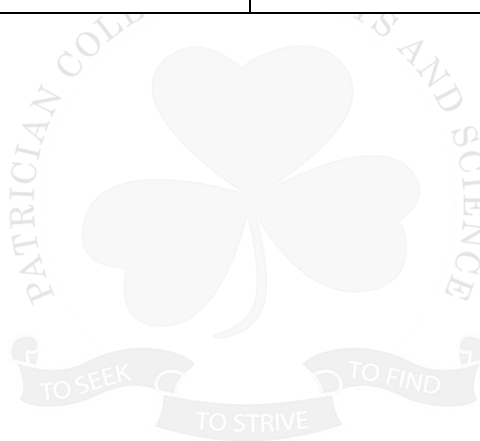

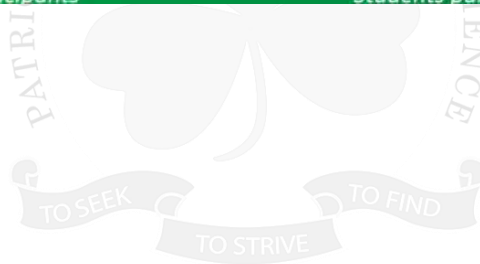
BSc Computer Science

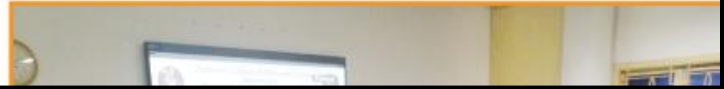
