SPORTS DAY 2018-2019

The College 18th Annual sports day was inaugurated by Our Director and Secretary, Rev. Bro. Johnson Rex Dhanabal, on 1st August 2018. The inaugural sports event began with a warm prayer led by our college choir Shamrock. Thereafter, the college flag was hoisted by Principal Dr. A. Joseph Durai, Monika of III BA English and M. B. Ranjeeth of III B.Com (Gen) Sports Secretaries to mark the commencement of the track and field events. The Olympic torch was ignited by our Director and Secretary, Rev. Bro. Johnson Rex Dhanabal, Principal Dr. A. Joseph Durai and Vice Principal Dr. Arokiamary Geetha Doss and was passed on to Naresh of III BCA, Athletes captain. The Olympic torch was relayed to other athletes and the final leg was led by the student Sports Secretaries, Monika of III BA English and M. B. Ranjeeth of III B.Com (Gen). After the official inauguration of the sports day events various intramural games were conducted on the same day.

The prize distribution ceremony for the completed sports events was held on Wednesday 12th September 2018 in the Auditorium. The chief guest for the day was Dr. A. Joseph Durai, Principal, Patrician College of Arts and Science. He distributed medals and certificates to the students who won prizes in various games and track and field events.

The much awaited Annual Sports Day was held on Saturday 15th September 2018, with great zeal, excitement and frolicking atmosphere. The programme began with flag hoisting ceremony by the chief guest of the day Mr. V Nandakumar, IRS, Joint Commissioner of Income Tax, Aayakar Bhavan, Chennai. Dr. A Joseph Durai, Principal, Patrician College of Arts and Science delivered the welcome address. The chief guest of the day Mr. V Nandakumar, IRS declared the sports meet open and took the salute of the impressive March Past of the students.

The students entered into the spirit of the occasion in a grand way with the oath being administered by the Sports Secretary. An energizing march-past display set the tone for the rest of the event. The students exhibited their versatility through welcome dance and aerobics



performances mesmerizing the audience with their energetic performances. Once the races began, the air was filled with cheering and tons of encouragement for the young athletes.

Mr. V Nandakumar, IRS gave an inspiring talk to the students with the flurry of real life illustrations and the anecdotes from the sporting legends. He urged the students not to give up and to have high self-esteem. In his speech he applauded the Welcome dance team for their enthusiastic show. He enlightened the students to overcome the personality cramps which they tend to face in life after they complete their studies. He advised the students to set a target and take calculative steps with persistent hard work to attain goals of their lives. He insisted the students to give equal importance to Extra-curricular activities to survive in this competitive world, whereas a successful life requires a combination of both curricular and Extra-curricular skills. Soon after the Chief Guest address various trophies and medals were distributed to the students.

The Best march past trophies were awarded to BBA, B.Com (CS) and B.Com (G) departments bagging I, II and III places respectively. Individual championship for Women trophy was awarded to M. Rekha from II M.Com scoring 1167 Points calculated through IAAF Scoring Format and the Individual championship for Men trophy was awarded to Luqueman Gani of III B.Com (G) with the scoring point of 2401. The overall winner's trophy was awarded to B.Com (G) department with the scoring point of 216

The overall runner's trophy was awarded to B.C.A. department with the scoring point of 151 and the overall second runners trophy was awarded to B.Sc. Mathematics department with the scoring point of 73.

Keeping up the solemnity in the air the Olympic flag and college flag was lowered by the Physical Directress Dr. Sathiyavathi. The flags were carefully folded and handed over to the Principal Dr. A Joseph Durai and the flags will be kept under safe custody till the next sports meet. The sports secretaries from the Students council proposed the vote of thanks and the day ended with the National Anthem.
