Keeping up the solemnity in the air the Olympic flag and college flag was lowered by the Physical Directress Dr. Sathiyavathi. The flags were carefully folded and handed over to the Principal Dr. A Joseph Durai and the flags will be kept under safe custody till the next sports meet. 
